Hello VCSDA Members,

First, notice that Anthony Miller is our new full time secretary. Anthony has just recently started with PVRPD.

Second, a new state law which goes into effect July 1st will replace all local RDA/Successor Oversight Agencies within the county with just one county wide Successor Oversight Agency. This is of key importance to our special districts because for the first time the independent special districts will have a seat on the successor oversight committee. In the past the local (each city) successor oversight committees did not have any independent special district representation. Ventura County government has decided that the existing LAFCo election process will be used to select our one representative. I will update everyone about the LAFCo election for successor oversight committee process status at the April 3rd meeting.

Third, remember that the CSDA's Special District Legislative Days is scheduled for May 22-23 at the Sacramento Convention Center.

Fourth, we all need to think about what issues should VCSDA recommend to CSDA to focus on for 2018. We will cover this topic at our meeting.

Talk topic is **"Property Taxes Overview and RDA/ Successor Agencies"**. Jeff and Michelle will describe how property taxes are divided up and paid out to the various districts. Then the subject of Redevelopment Agencies (RDA), now renamed Successor Agencies, is covered. There are 11 successor agencies (one per each city and one county) across Ventura County. These successor agencies reduce property tax payments to some districts. Starting July 1st, with a new state law, all local successor oversight committees will be replaced with just one county wide successor oversight committee. And for the first time, the independent special districts will have one seat on this county wide oversight committee.
